## ELIZABETH TOWER OF LONDON

### INTRODUCTION

Elizabeth Tower is the official name of the tower in which Big Ben is located. Big Ben is the nickname for the Great Bell of the clock at the north end of the Palace of Westminster in London and is usually extended to refer to both the clock and the clock tower. It was completed in 1859. Upon completion, it was the largest four-faced chiming clock and the third-tallest free-standing clock tower in the world. The Big Ben Clock is used to ring in the New Year in London and is the rallying point for the New Year's celebration of the entire country of England. It has become a symbol of London and the United Kingdom. The main bell, officially known as the Great Bell but better known as Big Ben, is the largest bell in the tower. It weighs almost 14 tons (12,700 kg). The four clocks are each 23 ft (7 m) in diameter. The hour hand is 9 ft (2.7 m) long and the minute hand is 14 ft (4.25 m) long. The four clock dials are 180 ft (55 m) aboveground. The clock's movement is famous for its remarkable reliability. The engineering of the clock is such that the actual mechanisms of the clock itself are well protected from climate changes and harsh weather. During the two World Wars, Big Ben continued to run accurately.

## TOUR ELIZABETH DE LONDRES

La tour Elizabeth est le nom de la tour qui abrite Big Ben. Big Ben est le surnom de la grande cloche qui se trouve au sommet de la tour Elizabeth, à l'extrémité nord du Palais de Westminster et le nom de la cloche est aussi communément employé pour désigner l'horloge dans son ensemble et la tour qui abrite le tout. Elle fut complétée en 1859. Il s'agissait alors de la plus grande tour d'horloge à quatre cadrans et la troisième tour d'horloge la plus haute au monde. Tous les ans, Big Ben résonne au cœur de la tour de l'Horloge pour annoncer le Nouvel An, le son est retransmis partout au pays. Elle est devenue un symbole iconique de Londres et de l'Angleterre. La cloche principale, The Great Bell, mieux connue sous le nom de Big Ben, est la plus grosse cloche dans la tour. Elle pèse presque 14 tonnes (12 700 kg). Les quatre horloges de la tour ont chacune un diamètre de 7 mètres (23 pi). Les aiguilles des heures mesurent 2,7 mètres (9 pi) et les aiguilles des minutes mesurent 4,2 mètres (14 pi). Les quatre horloges se trouvent à 55 mètres (180 pi) du sol. Le mouvement de l'horloge est célèbre pour sa fiabilité remarquable. L'ingénierie de l'horloge et ses mécanismes sont bien protégés contre les changements climatiques et les intempéries. Durant les deux Guerres mondiales, l'horloge ne cessa pas de fonctionner.
