# THE WHITE HOUSE OF WASHINGTON

## INTRODUCTION

The White House is the official residence and principal workplace of the President of the United States, located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue NW in Washington, D.C. It has been the residence of every U.S. president since 1800. The house was designed and built between 1792 and 1800 of white-painted Aquia Creek sandstone in the Neoclassical style. In 1801, added low colonnades on each wing that concealed stables and storage. After a fire in 1814, reconstruction began and partially reconstructed the Executive Residence in October 1817. Construction continued with the addition of the semicircular South portico in 1824 and the North portico in 1829. Because of crowding within the executive mansion itself, all work offices relocated to the newly constructed West Wing in 1902. Eight years later, expanded the West Wing and created the first Oval Office which was eventually moved as the section was expanded. In the main mansion, the third-floor attic was converted to living quarters in 1927 by augmenting the existing hip roof with long shed dormers. A newly constructed East Wing was used as a reception area for social events; Jefferson's colonnades connected the new wings. East Wing alterations were completed in 1946, creating additional office space. By 1948, the house's loadbearing exterior walls and internal wood beams were found to be close to failure. Under Henry S. Truman, the interior rooms were completely dismantled and a new internal loadbearing steel frame constructed inside the walls. Once this work was completed, the interior rooms were rebuilt.

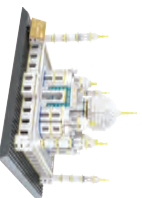

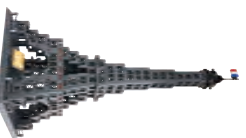

# LA MAISON-BLANCHE DE WASHINGTON

La Maison-Blanche est la résidence officielle et l'espace de travail principal du président des États-Unis, laquelle est située au 1600, avenue Pennsylvania NW à Washington, D.C. Depuis 1800, elle a été la résidence de tous les présidents. La Maison-Blanche a été imaginée et construite, entre 1792 et 1800, à partir de grès blanchi du ruisseau Aquia inspirée du style néoclassique. En 1801, furent ajoutés des colonnades sur chaque aile qui cachaient l'emplacement et les écuries. Après un feu en 1814, une reconstruction commença et en 1817, une portie de la résidence exécutive fut reconstruite. En 1824, les améliorations ont continué avec l'ajout du portique sud semicirculaire et en 1829, avec l'ajout du portique nord. En raison du manque d'espace dans la maison exécutive, tous les bureaux furent rélocalisés dans la nouvelle aile ouest, qui fut construite en 1902. Huit ans plus tard, l'aile ouest fut agrandie et le bureau ouest fut créé et éventuellement bougé au fur et à mesure que la section fut agrandie. En 1927, dans la maison principale, le grenier du troisième étage fut converti en logements en augmentant la toiture en croupe avec des longues lucarnes rampantes. Une aile nouvellement construite servit comme aile de réception pour des événements sociaux et les colonnades de Jefferson furent connectées à ce nouvel aile. Les modifications à l'aile est furent complétées en 1946, ajoutant des bureaux additionnels. En 1948, les murs extérieurs portants et la structure de bois internes étaient près de l'effondrement. Sous Henry S. Truman, les pièces intérieures furent complètement démolies et une nouvelle structure portante en acier fut construite à l'intérieur des murs. Une fois ces travaux terminés, les pièces intérieures furent reconstruites.
