CATHEDRAL NOTRE-DAME OF PARIS

INTRODUCTION

Noire-Dame of Paris, meaning "Our Lady of Paris" is also known as Noire-Dame Cathedral or simply Notre-Dame, it is a medieval Catholic cathedral east of the Île de la Cité in the fourth arrondissement (district) of Paris, France. The cathedral is widely considered to be one of the finest examples of French Gothic architecture, and it is among the largest and most well-known church buildings in the world. The naturalism of its sculptures and stained glass are in contrast with earlier Romanesque architecture. To begin the construction, Bishop Maurice de Sully had several houses demolished and had a new road built to transport materials for the cathedral. Construction began in 1163 during the reign of Louis VII. Bishop de Sully devoted most of his life and wealth to the cathedral's construction. Construction of the choir took from 1163 until around 1177 and the new High Altar was consecrated in 1182. After Bishop Maurice de Sully's death in 1196, his successor, Eudes de Sully oversaw the completion of the transepts and pressed ahead with the nave, which was nearing completion at the time of his own death in 1208. By this stage, the western façade had also been laid out, though it was not completed until around the mid-1240s. The remaining elements were completed 1250-1345. Construction began in 1163, and the whole church was completed in 1345. The construction lasted more than 182 years.

CATHÉDRALE NOTRE-DAME DE PARIS

La cathédrale Notre-Dame de Paris, en forme courte Noire-Dame, est la cathédrale catholique médiévale située à l'est de l'île de la Cité dans le 4e arrondissement de Paris, en France. Elle est généralement considérée comme un des meilleurs exemples de l'architecture gothique de France. Elle est une des plus grosses églises au monde et une des plus connues. Le naturalisme des sculptures et des vitraux contraste avec l'architecture romanesque. Pour commencer les travaux, l'évêque Maurice de Sully dû démolir plusieurs maisons et une nouvelle route fut construite pour acheminer les matériaux nécessaires à la construction. En 1163, lors du règne de Louis VII, la construction débuta. L'évêque de Sully a consacré sa vie entière et sa fortune à la construction de la cathédrale. La construction du chœur a commencé en 1163 et il est achevé vers 1177 et le maître-autel est consacré en 1182. Après le décès de l'évêque Maurice de Sully en 1196, c'est son successeur, Eudes de Sully qui prend la relève de la construction des deux premières travées de la nef. Au moment de sa mort, en 1208, la construction de la nef et des transepts était presque terminée. À cette étape, l'édification de la façade était commencée, mais n'a été achevée qu'au milieu des années 1240. Les éléments restants furent complétés entre 1250 et 1345. La construction a commencé en 1163 et la cathédrale fut achevée en 1345. La construction a duré plus de 182 années.
